100+ Years of History



Kendall County Fair Association Inc.

(KCFA) saw its beginnings as the citizens of Boerne, Texas gathered together for the first time to share agricultural information, recipes and news of events on Sept. 4, 1905. Repeated each year this annual gathering became increasingly popular and on March 14, 1913, a meeting of concerned citizens was held for the purpose of organizing and incorporating Kendall County Fair Association and to establish its mission. On July 1, 1913, the corporation gained a charter as a nonprofit from the State of Texas. The Ferdinand Ludwig Von Herff family deeded 55.6 acres of land to the KCFA to be used for its annual county fair and to erect buildings for the event and for public use. Mr. H. O. Adler was the first president with Ms. Martha Fabra as the first manager of the ladies auxiliary for the KCFA. The KCFA has become an integral part of the Kendall County community and of its history, being that the organizations fundraiser, the Kendall County Fair, has been held annually for over 100 years. The land, now the beautiful Herff Park, located on River Road East, leading out of Boerne, is the home of KCFA and its annual fundraiser, the Kendall County Fair. The land is studded with live oak trees that give shade for the summer fundraiser (held on Labor Day Weekend) and is ideal for the mission of KCFA. It is utilized for various agriculture and livestock shows, agricultural education events and youth organizations, civic groups, other nonprofits and by the general public for various events and celebrations.
