

120TH KENDALL COUNTY FAIR PARADE RULES

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Welcome to the 120th Annual Kendall County Fair Parade! We're pleased that you will be joining in our celebrations. For the entertainment and safety of all who attend, we ask that you read the following guidelines:

- Parade will begin promptly at 10:30 AM.
- Parade Route: Starting on North Mains at Frederick Proceeding South on Main Street turning right on Hosack.
- Judging of the entries will begin at 10:00 AM in the staging area. You must be in place and all participants on the float to be judged. Judges will only pass once before making their final decision.
- Entries will be judged on: Originality, Theme, Costumes and its overall quality.
- Safety is our first priority – yours and our spectators! **KCFA reserves the right to remove any entrant from the parade due to safety concerns, or any other reason, either prior to assembly, while assembling or any time during the parade.**
- All participants are responsible for ensuring that the design and operation of their entry is safe and reliable.
- Drivers of any and all vehicles in the parade must possess a valid drivers' license, be at least 18 years old, and possess all liability vehicle insurance.
- Drivers of any and all vehicles in the parade shall not have consumed alcoholic beverages. All city, county and TX state statutes concerning the consumption of alcoholic beverages will be strictly enforced by the police before and during the parade.
- **All equine entries must have negative Coggins test within the past 12 months prior to the parade and must be accompanied by a cleanup patrol or wear proper gear to keep our streets clean for other participants and spectators.**
- Application fees are non-refundable for accepted entries.
- Applicant ensures children (under 15 years of age) in parade unit will be adequately supervised from parade lineup to completion.
- It is the responsibility of parents and/or guardians with children participating in the parade to make necessary arrangements to have children met and picked up at designated points.
- Candy or other promotional items may be SAFELY given to the parade spectators. **Any participants caught throwing candy or objects in the intent to harm any person or group, will be asked to exit the parade.**
- For safety purposes, it is recommended that helmets be worn by all riders of bicycles, skateboards, inline skates, scooters (motorized or not), motorcycles, equine entries, etc.
- **KCFA will have a ZERO tolerance policy for those choosing to abuse our volunteers or our entries. Please promptly report violators to parade officials on route.**
- Any interpretation of parade rules, KCFA parade committee decisions shall be final. KCFA reserves the right to change or add to the rules as necessary for the safety of all participants and spectators. Advance notice will be given if at all possible. Entrants must observe all applicable rules and regulations and follow instructions from police and parade officials. Failure to comply with the parade rules will result in their removal from the parade (even if in progress) and may result in banning from future participation.



Rules & Instructions: City of Boerne Parades

All moving floats, powered vehicles (no semi-trucks allowed), horse drawn, mule drawn, walking/marching groups or otherwise not identified in this agreement will comply with the following criteria for participation. Failure to comply will result in the participant's removal without refund of the application fee. Said criteria are as follows:

1. So that everyone enjoys a safe parade, participants must refrain from throwing any items, such as candy, toys, jewelry, trinkets, ice, plastics, papers, etc., from your float. Failure to comply may result in your organization being escorted out of the parade.
2. Vehicle drivers must a.) be an adult b.) possess the appropriate license to drive the type of vehicle included in your parade entry.
3. Parade entry speed will not exceed 10 mph along the designated parade route at all times. Entries are to remain a safe distance from the crowd, the float in front of them, and maintain their assigned position throughout the duration of the parade.
4. No entry can stop or stall the parade for any reason. This includes performances and demonstrations. Such performances must be done while moving in a forward direction. Exceptions include emergency vehicles.
5. Once the parade has started, no entry will be permitted to drop out of the lineup unless there is a safety issue.
6. No smoking or drinking of alcohol beverages by participants before or throughout the duration of the parade. These actions will not be tolerated; participants will be expelled immediately upon failure to comply.
7. Groups with teens; please instruct your teens not to walk in the street against the flow of parade traffic! This is very dangerous!
8. Elementary-aged children are prohibited from walking alongside the vehicles on the same entry. Elementary-aged children must be inside/on the vehicle/float.
9. All horse entries must have bun-bag/diaper or someone with a "poop-scoop" during the parade and show proof of a negative Coggins test within the past 12 months prior to the parade.
10. Entries may not engage in behavior or actions that would endanger themselves or spectators along the street.
